The Korea Hapkido Federation are strategically co-operating with KT (Korean Telecom).



The KHF will soon have 23 official websites and KT are sponsors of the websites. In addition to the main Korea Hapkido Federation website and the English language version website, there will be 21 City and Regional Branch Office websites. All 23 websites are in development and are 50% complete. Information about books and about local Hapkido gyms and events will be amongst that which is included in the content of the websites.

The 13th Korea Hapkido Federation Masters' Course was held for 3 days and 2 nights - from 30 April until 2 May 2005, in Po Chun Bears Town, outside of Seoul.

The Course generated great interest throughout the participants, and everyone who participated worked hard throughout. The Masters participated in the Course from 6am – 8pm. The subject content was:

- Chiropractics Course – Chiropractics Education Director, Master Lee Dong Woo
- Understanding the body in relation to Hapkido - Grandmaster Lee Tae June
- Emergency Chiropractic Techniques - Grandmaster Kang Jung Soo
- Breathing Control - Chiropractics 2nd Director, Master Kil Ung
- Self Defence Course - Grandmaster Kim Jae Nam.
Grandmaster Kim Jae Nam worked very hard teaching the self-defence course and 300 members participated, evidence of the ever-growing popularity and expansion of the Korea Hapkido Federation.

The Korea Hapkido Federation has now announced the appointment of Master Kim June as the KHF Planning Director. The position of Korea Hapkido Federation Planning Director had been vacant since 3 January 2005.

Branch will host the Championship and all other City and Regional Branch Offices will provide their assistance to the hosts.
